

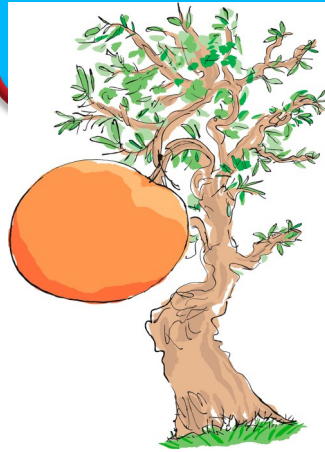
Geography
