

Science - In science, we will look at the plants and animals of Africa, including their life cycles. Through this, we will look at the life processes of humans and animals, including reproduction.



Maths - In maths, we learn in the areas of place value, number operations, fractions, decimals and percentages, statistics, measure, ratio and proportion and shape. Our work will include investigations and problem solving.

History - Our history work will be based on the ancient civilization of Benin, including how it changed following the arrival of European settlers.

English - We will be continuing with 'Talk for Writing', we will be learning texts and writing in many different genres. These will include: narrative poetry, defeating a beast stories, persuasive writing and information texts.



Geography - Our Geography work will be based upon studying African countries on a map and exploring the differences between Africa and the UK.

RE - In our R.E lessons, we will be learning about different religions, including their creation stories and important religious ceremonies.

Art - In art, we will be learning about colour and tones by mixing paint and exploring a colour wheel; this will also focus on complimentary and contrasting colours. We will then be painting African sunset scenes using silhouettes.

PSHE - We will be learning about democracy and the life of Nelson Mandela; including exploring segregation and cultural differences.

Computing - As well as building upon the children's digital literacy and E-Safety knowledge, we will also begin to look at computer programming through Scratch.

D.T. - Linking to the children's work on Benin, we will be designing and creating patterns through weaving with different materials.

PE - This will take place twice a week. One session will be taught by the class teacher whilst the second will be taught by Chris, the PE coach.

French - The children are learning lots of new vocabulary and developing their confidence in speaking French!

Music - This term, the children will be following a music scheme called Active Music. They will be looking at: instrumental, pitch, singing, rhythm and pulse.
