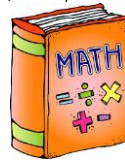
Write a narrative poem to describe the elephant graveyard scene in the Lion King

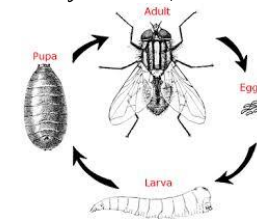
**Maths**
