Maths

Science

In Science this term, children will be learning about food chains, the digestive system and electricity! They will be carrying out investigations linked to these areas of science and creating their own electronic quiz game.

Languages

The children will be learning various songs to help them learn new French words. They will be learning how to say foods and sports.
