

History - Our history work will be based on crime and punishment. We will explore the ways in which both have changed throughout the years.




Maths - In maths we are learning about place value, number operations, fractions, decimals and percentages, statistics, measure, ratio and proportion and geometry. Our work will include investigations and problem solving.

Literacy - During our literacy work, we will continue with our Talk for Writing work. We will be learning texts and writing in many different genres, including: Non-Chronological reports, Poetry, Newspaper reports and Warning Stories.

Science - Science will involve looking at the properties and changes of certain materials. Furthermore, our work in this area will also link very heavily to the term's DT work on making bread. The Science experiments will be doing are: Irreversible changes- Exploring how a nail rusts in different conditions. Reversible changes- Exploring which conditions helps a salt solution evaporate. Separating mixtures- Using different items to separate a mixture.

Computing - The children will continue to follow the "Switched On" computing scheme.. We will be focusing on We are Artists and We are Web Developers.

R.E. - In our R.E lessons we will be learning about aspects of different religions, including Islam and Christianity. These sessions will be taught by Mrs Allen.
