Topic – ‘Volcanoes’		
<p><b>Geographer</b></p> <p>Present this any way you’d like... Somehow show us on a World map where the world’s volcanoes are.</p>	<p><b>Chef</b></p> <p>Make a cake or biscuits and somehow decorate it/them with a volcano theme.</p>	<p><b>Artist</b></p> <p>Having learned about Jackson Pollock in class (and soon Roy Lichtenstein – however you can give yourself a head start) practise some art in their style.</p>
<p><b>Shopkeeper/ mathematician</b></p> <p>Notice and list the capacity (ml), weight (g/kg) or price (£/p) of household items you come across in shops or at home.</p>	<p><b>Researcher</b></p> <p>Watch a volcano programme, internet clip or read some research from a book – write down what you find out, ready to tell the class.</p>	<p><b>Author</b></p> <p>Write a story that features a volcano. For an extra challenge, try making your story into a book, and illustrate it too.</p>
<p><b>Illustrator</b></p> <p>Draw and colour a comic strip about a volcano. If you want to add speech bubbles you can.</p>	<p><b>Horticulturalist</b></p> <p>Observe a growing plant every week this half term. Make notes and drawings of its changes. If you want to plant one (a bulb or seed) to observe.</p>	<p><b>Artistic Creator</b></p> <p>Create a volcano themed superhero. Draw &amp; colour them and their superhero outfit. Give them a name and some powers. Add some sidekicks (friend/pet) if you want to, maybe even a superhero home or vehicle.</p>
