

Learning missed in Reception

To begin the year our learning will be focused on ensuring the children have had the opportunity to catch up on missed learning due to Covid. They will be assessed alongside the Early Learning Goals towards the end of September and as is standard in the transition to year 1, their learning will be adapted and differentiated to meet their individual needs.

English

The children will be developing their skills in reading, writing and spoken language. They will all continue to take part in daily phonics lessons and will then use these skills in all written tasks. We will focus on letter formation, saying and then recording simple sentences and using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops within all written work.

PE

Children will have P.E every Thursday and Friday. Please make sure your child comes to school with weather appropriate PE kit (we will be outside) and without earrings.

RE

This term the children will be taught RE by Mrs Allen and will be exploring special people in Judaism and Christianity.

PSHE

As part of our personal, social and health education, children will be learning about "beginning and belonging" and their family and friends. We will have lots of discussions around these topics. The children also take part in daily mindfulness activities

All about me

Maths

In year 1 we complete a daily "maths meeting" practicing our number skills, we also take part in the whole school "times table championship". Please help your child with this, they will bring home their sheet each Friday.

Our maths lessons will be focusing on number work. We will be recognising the written word and symbols for numbers, solving calculation problems and continuing to count in 2, 5 and 10.

Art and D&T

In art this term, children will develop a variety of skills by focusing on self – portraits. They will draw, paints, photograph and collage these taking inspiration from studied artists.

The children will have numerous opportunities to use different tools to manipulate materials and develop their use of scissors, glue etc to create art work and class projects.

History

Children be learning about changes in living memory, looking at old toys and how these are different from what they play with. They will also be learning about Florence Nightingale to link in with our science lessons.

Geography

The children will be describing where we live and looking at maps of the local area.

Science

In Science this term, children will be learning about animals including humans. We will be learning about our 5 senses, why we need a healthy diet and the stages of development.

We will also be observing seasonal change as we move into Winter.

Computing

The children will be using purple mash for computing this term and learning about online safety, grouping and sorting and pictograms. Please help your child learn how to log on to purple mash independently at home.
