

Home learning guidelines for parents

Following the government expectation there will be home learning provided by the school if your child is unable to attend the school due to the class bubble or the school needing to close.

Teachers will be delivering a virtual lesson each day, at the same time (Monday to Friday) during term time. The school will inform you the time of this lesson in the event of closure. Tasks will be available for this session if the child is unable to attend the live lesson.

Teachers will also be available on-line via PurpleMash on Monday-Thursday between 9-12:15 /1-3pm and Friday 9-12 to support children as necessary during term time.

Home learning will include a virtual lesson, on-line tasks using BBC bitesize, the Oaks and other high-quality educational resources. If your children do not have access to technology please inform the school office so we can provide paper copies of the work.

Guidelines for all Video calls and Video lessons

- The parent/carer must make sure that their child and other members of the household are aware the video call/lesson is happening.
- Staff, children and other members of the household must wear suitable clothing.
- Devices should be used in appropriate areas, for example not in bedrooms.
- Language must be professional and appropriate including any family members in the background.
- Video calls/lessons will only be with prior agreement with the parent/carer or at a pre-arranged time published on PurpleMash and logged.
- Parents will need to appear on screen at the start of the lesson to confirm they give consent for their child to be part of the group conversation.
- If the teacher has any concerns about children or other members of the household using unsuitable language, dress, location, the conversation will be ended and concerns will be passed onto the headteacher
