

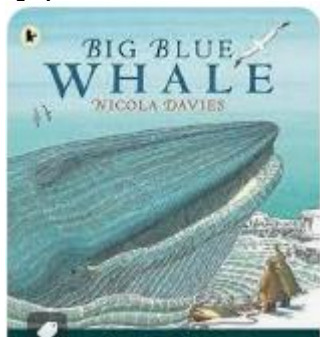
Year 1 Summer Term 2 Homework
