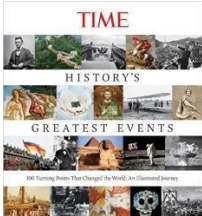


Year 5 Autumn 1 Homework Sheet

<u>English/History</u> Create a poster about the important changes which have occurred during our countries history. Include: Images and diagrams. 	<u>Art</u> Create a 'historical' themed image. Try to think of some unique ways in which you could create your design. Think about fine shading and fine detail. 	<u>English/Science</u> Conduct an experiment with an ice cube to see how quick it melts. Write a prediction then conduct the experiment. Hold it in your hand (time it and write it down), Run it under warm water (time it and record it) and leave it in the open (time it and record it). Was your prediction correct? What did you find out? Which method melted it the quickest?
<u>English</u> Create a descriptive piece of writing about one important historical character. Guy Fawkes, Queen Victoria, Henry the eighth etc. 	<u>English</u> Create a diary entry about Guy Fawkes and what he was planning to do with the government. 	<u>English</u> If you have recently finished a book. Write a book review! Make sure you include, if you enjoyed the book, if you would recommend it to your friends and class mates and rate the book out of 5. 
<u>Math</u> Create a mathematical worded problem based of years in the past or historical events. (They must include multiplication (4x2 digit numbers), addition (up to 6 digit numbers) and subtraction (up to 6 digit numbers)).	<u>Science/English</u> Conduct a science experiment which consists of change. Write about your findings and explain what your experiment consisted of. 	<u>All</u> Create a historical based game. It could link to English, Science, Math or History. You could even use horrible histories to help! Don't forget you will need a set of instructions as well!
