

English Read for 20 minutes every day and record this in your reading records, these need to be in school every day. Practise the spelling rule we have been learning each week (these spellings will be sent home weekly). Learn the year 5/6 spellings.	Additional English Learn a poem to recite to the class or a small audience. Think about your expression and gestures when practising. You can choose the poem you would like to recite or if you're stuck, you can take home one of the war poems we will be focusing on in class.	Maths Use Timetables Rockstars to keep your mental skills quick and accurate. Review your answers in the weekly maths arithmetic test. This should take no longer than 20 minutes.
PSHE Have a go at home- mindfulness. This could be free drawing different shapes on paper and carefully colouring them in, having a nature walk- have a trip to the beach and focus on the sounds of the waves or any other activity that can help you feel calm.	History We are learning about the experiences of evacuees during the second world war. If possible, ask about the experiences of someone you know, such as a family member or family friend and record their experiences in your homework book. If you do not know anyone who was evacuated in the war you can research online for recounts and record a summary.	Science We are learning about the human circulatory system later this term. Make sure that you are exercising regularly and taking note of your heart rate. Does it change quickly after exercise? Keep a note of your resting and active heart rates to see what changes over the half term.
