

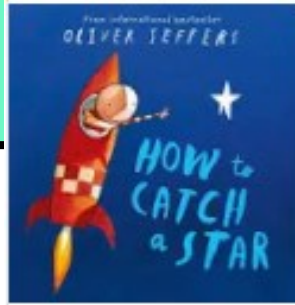
Year 1 Curriculum Map

Seasons and Celebrations.



English

The children will be developing their skills in reading, writing and spoken language. They will all continue to take part in daily Read Write Inc phonics lessons and will then use these skills in all written tasks. We will focus on letter formation, saying and then recording simple sentences and using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops within all written work. We will be using 'The Enormous Turnip' and 'How to Catch a Star' as texts to support our reading and writing. We will also be writing our own poems about what's inside a spider's pocket.



Maths

Our maths lessons will be focusing on number work. We will be recognising the written word and symbols for numbers, place value and solving calculation problems within 10. We will also be exploring 2d and 3d shape.

History

Children be learning about changes in living memory, looking at old toys and how these compare with their own toys. We will also learn about the Gunpowder Plot and Remembrance day.

Geography

The children will be observing the weather across the day / across a week / across a season and recording weather charts. They will match appropriate clothing and weather dependent items.

PE

Children will have P.E twice a week. Please make sure that your child comes to school with weather appropriate PE kit and without earrings. We will focus on ball skills in our outside sessions and gymnastics and dance in our indoor sessions his term.

Art

The children will have various opportunities to use different tools and media to create their own art work. Including colour monsters, firework nights, clay poppies and stars.

DT

The children will be using textiles to design and make their own snowman hand puppets. The children will also be learning how to make sliders when they design and make Christmas cards.



RE

Unit 1 Philosophy – What do my senses tell me about the world?
Unit 2 Human and Social science – How does a celebration bring a community together?

PSHE

As part of our personal, social and health education, children will be learning about "beginning and belonging" and their "family and friends." We will also join in with national Anti-Bullying week. We will have lots of discussions around these topics.

Music

Unit 1 Rhythm and Pulse
We will also learn Christmas songs for our Christmas performance.

Computing

The children will be using purple mash for computing this term and learning about online safety. Next they will learn how to create a jigsaw and a game. Finally they will learn about grouping, sorting and pictograms. Please help your child learn how to log on to purple mash independently at home.

Science

In Science this term, we will be using the school grounds to learn about seasonal change. We will begin to learn about materials and their properties.
