

Year 1 Curriculum map

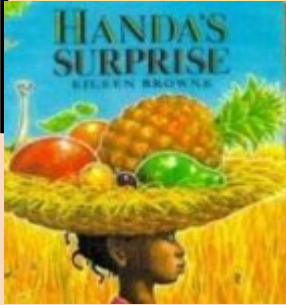
Fruit and

English

The children will continue to develop their reading and writing skills through our English lessons, daily phonics sessions, reading activities and within our topic learning. The children will also continue to learn to form their letters correctly within our daily handwriting lessons.

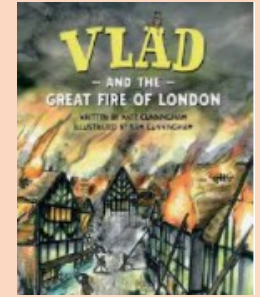
This term we will use 'Handa's Surprise' and 'Amazing Antelopes' as texts to support our Talk for Writing.

Science

In Science this term, children will be learning more about our senses.

We will continue to be observing seasonal change as we move into the new year and from Winter into Spring.

We will also begin learning about other animals and how to sort them into mammals, birds or fish. We will also look at what animals eat and how they can be sorted into carnivores, omnivores and herbivores.

Computing

We will be using Purple Mash to learn how to use the direction keys, create and follow instructions and create animated story books. The children need to be able to log in and out of Purple mash, please help them learn how to do this independently at home.

Art

The children will be using oil pastels to make observational drawings of fruit. We will be looking at the work of other artists and investigating colour through our paintings of the Great Fire of London. We will be making Mother's day cards and Easter cards.

Maths

Our maths lessons will continue to develop our understanding of number moving to place value and addition and subtraction within 20. We will then move on to place value within 50. Then we will learn about length and height and finally mass and volume.



Geography

PE
