

History - Our history work will be based on crime and punishment. We will explore the ways in which both have changed throughout the years.



Computing - The children will be increasing their breadth of Computing knowledge and ability to apply their skills to new concepts. The units we follow this term are quizzing, databases and Game Creator

R.E. - In our R.E lessons we will be learning about the enquiry : Is believing in God reasonable?

PE - This will take place twice a week: Monday and Thursday. One session will be swimming on a Monday whilst the second will be taught by the PE coach. We will be focusing on running, jumping and catching as well as playing competitive games.

Maths - In maths, we learn in the areas of place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions. Our work will include investigations and problem solving.

Literacy - This term we will be reading our class book is The Boy at the Back of the Class. We will be using the Talk for Writing approach to write a build up to a suspense story, a fantasy story, discussion texts and poetry.

Music - This term, the children will be learning about rhythm and pulse using the claves.



PSHCE - We will be learning about rights, rules and responsibilities and diversity and communities linked to democracy and the life of Nelson Mandela as well as to our class text, Holes and our work on crime and punishment.

French - The children are developing their confidence in speaking French focusing on Healthy Eating and musical instruments.

Science - Science will involve looking at the properties and changes of certain materials. Furthermore, our work in this area will also link very heavily to the term's DT work on making bread. The Science experiments will be doing are: Irreversible changes- Exploring how a nail rusts in different conditions. Reversible changes- Exploring which conditions helps a salt solution evaporate. Separating mixtures- Using different items to separate a mixture.



Art - In art we will be looking at figures in motion. During this unit we will practice sketching with a variety of materials, such as chalk and charcoal.

Design and Technology - Linking to the children's science work, we will be designing and baking our own bread.
