

**Science** - This term, the children will learn about the difference in the lifecycles of a mammal, amphibian, insect and a bird. There will be lots of opportunities for investigation, including the lifecycle of a butterfly and the conditions needed to grow plants.

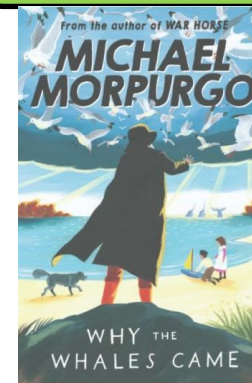

**Geography** - The children's geography work this term is strongly focused on the oceans of the world. This will include naming major bodies of water on Earth and locating oceans and seas on maps and globes.
